At its Special meeting held on Tuesday 19th January, 2021, the University Senate made the following resolutions with regards to opening of the University amidst the Covid-19 pandemic:

Fulltime Students

A blended learning approach will be adopted for all fulltime students and will run as follows:

1. First year students

You will report on **Saturday and Sunday**, 20th and 21st February, 2021 at the Great North Road campus for physical (face-face) classes and are expected to be on campus until Friday 9th April, 2021. You will thereafter be expected to travel back to your homes and continue with on-line classes until Friday, 28th May, 2021.

2. Second and third year students in ALL Schools, and fourth year Engineering Students

You will commence with on-line classes on Monday, 22nd February, 2021 until Friday 9th April, 2021. Thereafter all second and third year science based students will report on Saturday, 10th April, 2021 and non-science based Students Are expected to report on Sunday, 11th April, 2021 for physical (face-face) classes upto 28th May, 2021.

3. Final year Students

All final year students will report on **Sunday 21st February**, **2021** for physical (face-face) classes until the end of semester (28th May, 2021).

4. Bachelor of Science in Nursing Students

You are expected to follow sessional dates as provided by the School of medicine and Health Sciences and report accordingly.

5. Bachelor of Medicine and Bachelor of Surgery students

You are expected to follow sessional dates as provided by the School of medicine and Health Sciences and report accordingly.

All students are advised that a schedule of fees will be posted and will indicate how much each category of students will be expected to pay for the second semester.

I further wish to assure you that sufficient preparations have been put in place in order to safely receive you and ensure that you stay in a COVID-19 free environment.
